jewellery can have different designs and materials which include stainless steel titanium or even Gold. The professional piercer will first check the ventral surface of the tongue for large blood vessels and then mark for the placement of the piercing. The tongue is clamped with forceps and using a sterilized needle the hole is created after which the jewellery is then inserted into the hole. The tongue piercings are relatively of a low pain type, and considered to be relatively bearable, since it does not pierce the skin or cartilage. tongue piercings tend to heal quickly by taking about 4 to 8 weeks. During this time, the tongue swells up to double its size and hence activities like smoking, alcohol consumption or other sexual activities should be avoided. Tongue piercings like any other body piercings can come with several risks which include infection, swelling that persists for a longer duration, damage to the teeth or gums. Hence it is required to follow proper after care to avoid these risks.

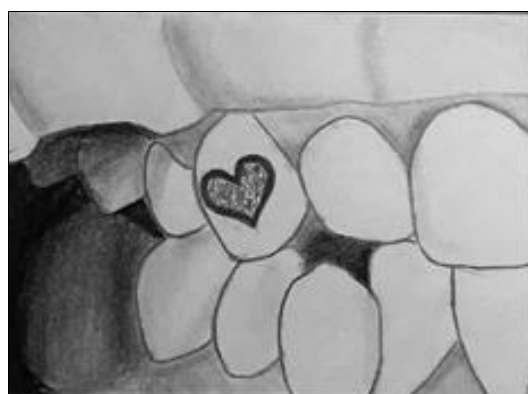


Fig 1: Tooth tattoo.

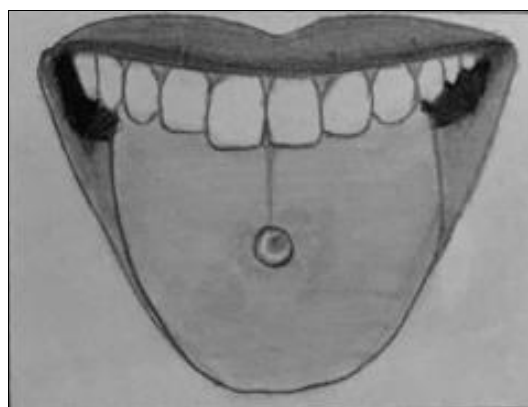


Fig 2: Tongue piercing.

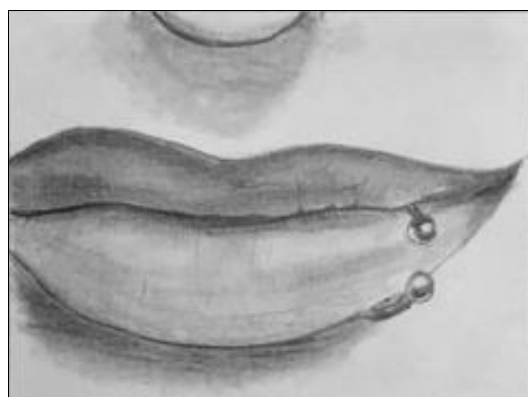


Fig 3: Lip piercing

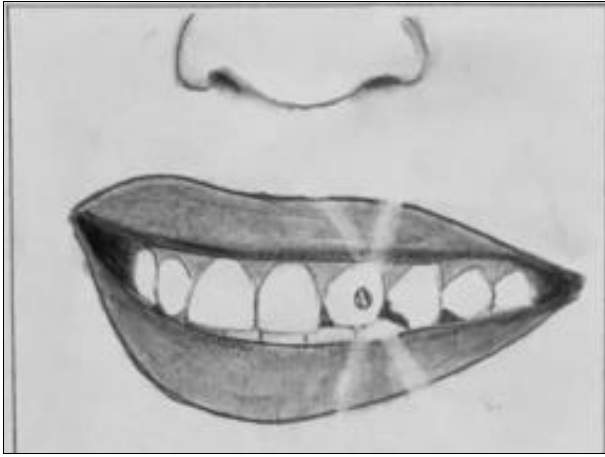


Fig 4: Tooth jewelers
